RE: 2010 AUSTRALIAN YOUTH TEAM SELECTION TRIALS, 26-28 FEBRUARY.

---

In relation to the 2010 Australian Youth Team Selection Trials Championships to be held in Melbourne 26-28 February 2010 the following information is supplied:

Boxers who win a weight category to be contested at the Selection Trials will be considered by BAI for selection as one of the up to 7 boxers that will be entered by BAI in the 2010 Youth World Championships and be eligible to receive up to \$3,500 assistance from the Australian Commonwealth Games Association to compete in the 2010 Youth World Championships. Boxers selected by BAI to compete in the 2010 Youth World Championships can anticipate that they will be required to contribute approximately \$2,000, in addition to the ACGA contribution, to enable their participation in the 2010 Youth World Championships (the major component of this approx. \$2,000 contribution will be each boxer's 1/9 contribution to the costs of 2 coaches attending, as well as their competition clothing outfitting – BAI receives no funding from any of its sponsors for underage international boxing other than from this very welcome ACGA junior boxing program).

Additionally, boxers who are selected by BAI to compete in the 2010 Youth World Championships, if they finish in the first four boxers in their weight category at the Championships, may be selected to represent Australia at the 2010 Youth Olympic Games to be held in Singapore. AIBA will permit up to 3 eligible boxers per country (that is, boxers who finish in the first four of their weight category at the 2010 Youth World Championships) to compete in the 2010 Youth Olympic Games. However, the AOC has advised that at present it has made provision for only one Australian boxer to be in the Australian team. If Australia has more boxers who qualify than the AIBA quota, or the AOC quota, then BAI will select them in order of priority.

### **Equipment**

Only approved AIBA equipment is to be used at this event.

**Gloves** - will be supplied at the venue and no boxer will be permitted to use their own.

**Head guards** - will be available at the venue or boxers may bring their own. However, if personal head guards are to be used they **MUST** be **AIBA** approved. Please note that the only acceptable manufacturers are Adidas, Everlast or Top Ten. Greenhill head guards are not approved and may not be used.

**Bandages** - must also be AIBA approved and supplied by one of the three approved AIBA manufacturers (Adidas, Everlast or Top Ten). Adidas bandages will be available for sale at the event should participants need to purchase them.

### **Videos**

Boxing Victoria Inc. advises that it has an agreement that the event will be recorded by Big Dave's Videos, that videos can be ordered at the tournament, and that no other video recording will be permitted.

### **Meals**

Meals and refreshments will be on sale at the event throughout the tournament.
