Boxing Australia Inc. (BAI) invites applications for appointment to the positions of Team Manager and of Assistant Coach of the Australian Team to the International Boxing Association (AIBA) 2011 World Elite Men's Championships to be held in Baku, Azerbaijan 22 September - 10 October, 2011.

**Applications to BAI must be submitted through and endorsed by a BAI Member Association.**

Each BAI Member Association is permitted to submit and endorse to BAI as many Applications as it so determines.

Applications may be forwarded by hand, mail, fax or email.

The appointments of a Team Manager and of an Assistant Coach of the Australian Team to the 2011 Elite World Men's Championships are major decisions and will be given serious consideration by BAI because the holders of these two pivotal positions can have a significant influence on the performances of Australian Team members both in the ring and out of the ring at the Championships.

The person appointed to the position of Team Manager will be required to:

1. be the final authority on all decisions taken on behalf of the Australian Team during the Championships;
2. represent the Australian Team at all Manager's Meetings associated with the Championships;
3. effectively resolve all issues that impact on the overall performance and management of the Australian Team; and
4. set an example in behaviour, dress and commitment to all Team members during the Championships.

The person undertaking the role of Team Manager should possess the following attributes:

1. a demonstrated capacity to make decisions decisively in a challenging competitive environment;
2. a track record in team leadership and management;
3. excellent communication, negotiation and interpersonal skills;
4. demonstrated technical knowledge of AIBA competition rules; and

5. ability to address boxers and coaches with authority, confidence and sensitivity;
6. possession of a current boxing coach accreditation by the Australian Sports Commission's Coaching and Officiating Unit or possession of an internationally recognised coaching accreditation.

The person appointed to the position of Assistant Coach will be required to:

1. oversee the day to day training at the Championships of Team boxers;
2. monitor each boxer's performance at the Championships;
3. provide expert advice to boxers in the corner during the Championships; and
4. set an example in behaviour, dress and commitment to all Team boxers during the Championships.

The person undertaking the role of Assistant Coach will be required to possess the following attributes:

1. excellent interpersonal and communication skills with boxers;
2. experience as a coach and a capacity to provide leadership and direction to boxers;
3. demonstrated well developed organisational skills; and
4. possession of a current boxing coach accreditation by the Australian Sports Commission's Coaching and Officiating Unit or possession of an internationally recognised coaching accreditation.

Applicants for the positions must be nominated by a BAI Member Association.

Applicants for the Assistant Coach position must be registered as a coach with a BAI Member Association.
