

CRITERIA FOR EVALUATION OF JUDGES – AIBA: 2007

Evaluating Judges' Computer Scoring

Criterion 1 – The Accepted Score

The Judges individual accepted score (AS) must be not less than 50% of his/her individual score (IS).

If the accepted score is less than 50% of the individual score = CAUTION

If the accepted score is less than 30% of the individual score = WARNING

NB: For this to apply the Final Score must be 5 or more.

Example

Final Score

9 29

NB: If final score 4 29 there would be no Cautions or Warnings as red final score < 5.

Criterion 2a – High Average Score

A Judges individual score must not be greater than 25% of the average of the other Judges score.

If the individual Score is greater than 25% of the average = CAUTION

If the individual Score is greater than 50% of the average = WARNING

Example

	Judge 1	Judge 2	Judge 3	Judge 4	Judge 5
	Red Blue	Red Blue	Red Blue	Red Blue	Red Blue
IS	6 30	6 28	9 19	11 23	7 16

Judge 1 – Add Red $6+9+11+7 = 33 \div 4 = 8.25$ = Average score of judges 2,3,4,5.

Add Blue $28+19+23+16 = 86 \div 4 = 21.50$ = Average score of judges 2,3,4,5.

Red IS = 6 = not greater than average score = OK

Blue IS = 30 = 40% greater than average score = CAUTION

Judge 2 – Add Red $6+9+11+7 = 33 \div 4 = 8.25$ = Average score of judges 1,3,4,5.

Add Blue $30+19+23+16 = 88 \div 4 = 22.00$ = Average score of judges 1,3,4,5.

Red IS = 6 = not greater than average score = OK

Blue IS = 28 = 27% greater than average score = CAUTION

Judge 4 – Add Red $6+6+9+7 = 28 \div 4 = 7.00$ = Average score of judges 1,2,3,5.

Add Blue $30+28+19+16 = 93 \div 4 = 23.25$ = Average score of judges 1,2,3,5.

Red IS = 11 = 57% greater than average score = WARNING

Blue IS = 23 = not greater than average score = OK

NB: For this to apply the Final Score must be 3 or more.

CRITERIA FOR EVALUATION OF JUDGES – AIBA: 2007

Criterion 2b – Low Average Score

A Judges individual score must not be lower than 70% of the average of the other Judges score.

If the individual Score is less than 70% of the average = CAUTION

If the individual Score is less than 50% of the average = WARNING

Example

	Judge 1	Judge 2	Judge 3	Judge 4	Judge 5
	Red Blue	Red Blue	Red Blue	Red Blue	Red Blue
IS	6 30	6 28	9 19	11 23	7 16

Judge 5 – Add Red $6+6+9+11 = 32 \div 4 = 8.00$ = Average score of judges 1,2,3,4.

Add Blue $30+28+19+23 = 100 \div 4 = 25.00$ = Average score of judges 1,2,3,4.

Red IS = 7 $7/8 = 88\%$ of the average score = OK

Blue IS = 16 $16/25 = 64\%$ of the average score = CAUTION

NB: For this to apply the Final Score must be 3 or more.

Criterion 3 – The 4:1

If a judge's individual accepted score results in him/her being the odd one in a 4-1 result = WARNING

NB: When the individual accepted score is very close i.e. within 3 points or less this criterion does not apply.

Example

	Judge 1	Judge 2	Judge 3	Judge 4	Judge 5
	Red Blue	Red Blue	Red Blue	Red Blue	Red Blue
IS	15 20	18 22	17 26	20 16	14 21
AS	10 12	11 12	9 12	12 8	8 12

Final Score

13 15

Judge 4 – As his/her individual accepted score is the odd one out on a 4:1 decision = WARNING

NB: Had the individual accepted score been 12:10 all judges would be OK as difference in accepted score is 3 or less.

Please note that the **total evaluation** for a bout can be one of:

OK

CAUTION

WARNING.
